What is Payroll Giving?

Payroll Giving is a low-cost scheme that enables your employees to give to any UK charity straight from their gross salary (before tax is deducted), and to receive immediate tax relief of up to £4 for every £10 donated.

What's more, employers with less than 500 staff are eligible for a grant of up to £500 just for setting up Payroll Giving before December 2006.

What is the Payroll Giving Quality Mark?

It's a new scheme that recognises and rewards organisations of all sizes for making Payroll Giving available to their staff.

The Quality Mark comprises a certificate and logo as well as Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards.

How will my organisation be recognised and rewarded?

At its most basic level, employers with a Payroll Giving scheme will receive a certificate and logo for use on your letterheads, websites and other literature.

This acknowledges that you have implemented Payroll Giving and demonstrates your commitment to the good causes your employees care about.

About the Awards

The Awards reward employers for fostering a culture of committed giving in the workplace by actively promoting Payroll Giving.

Bronze, Silver or Gold?

Bronze Award



Awarded to employers that achieve 1% employee participation in Payroll Giving.

Silver Award



Awarded to employers that achieve 5% employee participation in Payroll Giving.

Gold Award



Awarded to employers that achieve 10% employee participation in Payroll Giving and pay the administration charge, match donations **or** have promoted Payroll Giving during the previous year.
